Participants are encouraged to add names/photos/candles to a visual memorial in the lot near the Hopeful sign, and then stand along both sides of Main Street in Lewiston with lights and signs to raise awareness during the evening commute until 5:30 pm (between Mill St./Hopeful sign and Lincoln St./Veteran's memorial). **PLEASE DRESS WARMLY – event will be held no matter the weather.**
